By-law (2004)-17551 states that:

'Every Licensee shall carry general liability insurance in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 throughout the term of the Licence and proof of such insurance shall be provided to the Clerk or his/her designate at the time an application is submitted ..' (The Corporation Of The City Of Guelph).
